5. God is never late we can settle that, the new American Standard Bible, 2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you.
6. Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they

shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint."

7. Ephesians 6:16 faith is a shield use it
8. 1 Thessalonians 3v10 Night and day, praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith.
9. 1 Corinthians 2:5 that your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.
10. Proverbs 14:12 There is a way that seems right to a man, but its end is the way to death
