TITLE: FAITH COMES WITH THE REVELATION OF
CHRIST

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: Galatians 1:12 *"For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but I received it through a revelation of Jesus Christ."*

1 Samuel 3:7 *"Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor had the word of the LORD yet been revealed to him."*

TRUTHS/NUGGETS

1. We need more revelation, less information.
2. Pray for the Spirit of wisdom and revelation. Ephesians 1:17 says, "[For I always pray to] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, **that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation** [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him" (AMP).
3. Faith follows revelation.
4. If Christ is veiled from you, faith cannot come.
5. When Christ is revealed we have confidence: "My redeemer liveth. "I know that my Redeemer lives" (see Job 19:25)
6. **YOUR FAITH BECOMES EFFECTIVE IN CHRIST**
Paul said, "I pray that ... your faith may become effective for the full knowledge of every good thing that is in us for the sake of Christ" (Philem. 1:6, ESV).
7. **WE ARE LIVING IN HIM AND HE IN US** 1 John 4:16-18 (MSG) 13-16 **"This is how we know we're living steadily and deeply in him, and he in us:** He's given us life

from his life, from his very own Spirit. Also, we've seen for ourselves and continue to state openly that the Father sent his Son as Savior of the world. Everyone who confesses that Jesus is God's Son, participates continuously in an intimate relationship with God. We know it so well, we've embraced it heart and soul, this love that comes from God.

8. NOTHING shifted my faith more than the revelation of Christ. **THAT I LIVE IN HIM AND HE LIVES IN ME.**
9. 1Cor 2:14 "But a natural man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised."
10. 1 Cor 2:10 says "For to us God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God."

FINAL THOUGHT

1. As a family we were born again for many years without the revelation of Christ.
2. We pay homage to the crucified Saviour but do not celebrate the risen Christ who has overcome death and hell.
3. He has given us the keys to the kingdom of heaven.
4. My faith comes not by knowledge and the wisdom of man, but by who He is and who I am in Him.
5. Paul's life changed dramatically when Christ was revealed on the road to Damascus.
6. Life starts at the burning bush, the upper room, the empty tomb. . .
