THESE ARE SOME TRUTHS ABOUT FAITH

- 1. Faith that has not been tested cannot be trusted.
- "Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials... so that you may be mature and complete." (James 1:2-4)
- 3. We grow in every trial. "These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold." (1 Peter 1:7)
- 4. FAITH IS A FIGHT, BUT A GOOD FIGHT.
- We have to fight our doubts and unbelief and the opinions of men that is contrary to the counsel of the Word of God.
- 6. The teacher remains quiet/silent for the duration of the test.
- 7. Rewards and promotion comes after the test.
- 8. Every test and trial of your faith will produce a defining moment of greatness.
- 9. "Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver; I have tested you in the furnace of affliction." (Isaiah 48:10)
- 10. All great anointings have been tested in the furnace. It is the crushed olive that produces the oil. I have seen in

- the Kingdom how brokenness produced wholeness/maturity.
- 11. It is the valley that prepares us for the mountain of success.
