TRUTHS/NUGGETS

1. Everyone that ever placed their trust in money learned the hard lesson: money fails in the day of trouble.
2. Money and Faith give substance to things hoped for yet faith in money destroys lives.
3. At lower levels of finance we trust God for provision, when deception comes in at higher levels we tend to trust money to meet our needs.
4. Deuteronomy 32:15 "But Jeshurun grew fat and kicked-- You are grown fat, thick, and sleek-- Then he forsook God who made him, and scorned the Rock of his salvation.
5. Hosea 13:6 As they had their pasture, they became satisfied, And being satisfied, their heart became proud; Therefore they forgot Me.
6. The tithe can sanctify your money. Romans 11:16 For if the firstfruit be holy, the lump is also holy: and if the root be holy, so are the branches.
7. He who trusts in money becomes a slave to money.
8. Faith in any man will be wrong.

9. True Faith is reflected in our trust in God.
10. When we believe in the things money can buy idols are created.
