TODAY'S SCRIPTURE: PSALM 41:3 The LORD will strengthen him upon the bed of languishing: you will restore his bed in his sickness. Jeremiah 17:14

4. **Exodus 23:25** *So you shall serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.*
5. **Psalm 30:2** *O LORD my God, I cried out to You, And You **healed** me.*
6. **Psalm 107:20** *He sent forth his word and **healed** them; he rescued them from the grave.*
7. **Jeremiah 33:6** *Nevertheless, I will bring health and **healing** to it; I will **heal** my people and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security.*
8. **Proverbs 16:24** *Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones.*

9. The word of God is health to my bones.
10. I have this confidence the Lord will sustain me;
Psalm 3:5 *I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the Lord sustained me.*
